INTERVIEW OF JUSTIN TIMBERLAKE

The Moderator: Good morning everyone, thank you for joining us today for the 2009 Justin Timberlake Shriners Hospital for Children Open teleprint conference call. We are pleased to have our host Justin Timberlake with us on today's call. Timberlake is a Grammy and Emmy award winner, and the 14th celebrity to host the PGA Tour Event.

The Justin Timberlake Shriners Hospital for Children Open will be played October 11 thru the 18th at the TPC in Las Vegas, Nevada. Over 72 holes with a championship ProAm on Wednesday the 14th. As part of the week's festivities on the Mandalay Bay Events Center will host the Justin Timberlake and Friends Concert to benefit the Shriners Hospital for Children on October 17th at 8:00 p.m.

Mr. Timberlake, would you care to make some opening comments as we get closer to the start of the event, and then we'll open it up from questions from the media dialing in.

Justin: Thank you. Me and the whole team that has put together the tournament, including the Shriners and PGA, we are all very excited to have our second year at this. And it's going to be even better than last year. And we hope that everyone can make it out. Thank you for being on the call today.

The Moderator: We'll now open it up to questions. Each writer will have an opportunity to ask one question regarding the Justin Timberlake Shriners Hospital for Children Open in the week's event only. This is a round-robin style call with questions determined by the call order. To please move things along please only ask one question.

Q Hey Justin, how you are doing this morning?

Justin: Good.

Q What made you decide to bring this event to Vegas to begin with? You can probably host this in a number of markets, but what made you decide to kick it off in Vegas?

Justin: It was a little more of a coincidence. It was, you know, my involvement with this whole tournament was purely out of having a conversation with the PGA a couple of years ago. And seeing if there was anyway we can team up to do something together and they brought up Las Vegas. And, you

know, thought it would be a good fit. And I immediately responded that I thought it would be interesting for someone like myself to host an event in Vegas; it's close to Los Angeles and, you know, it's obviously a fun town to do the event. So, it was more the PGA sort of putting it up for sale, so to speak, and us taking it.

I can't take credit for the idea.

The Moderator: And again that is star one if you would like to ask a question.

The next question comes from Aleza Freeman with Vegas.com.

Q Hey Justin?

Justin: Hello.

Q Good morning. I was wondering what it was about the Shriners Hospital, in particular The Shriners Hospital for Children that speaks to you, is there a particular child's case that touched you, or is it just the cause overall?

Justin: You know, it's probably more the cause overall. As I have sort of been involved in this tournament and seen what the Shriners do, it's remarkable what they are able to do with not a lot. So, I can't say that it's one particular instance. And to be honest, you know, I didn't know as much about the Shriners as I do now, before being involved with this tournament. I was just really blown away by what they are able to do.
