## AN INTERVIEW WITH AMANDA BLUMENHERST

(Interview by tape.)

JASON TAYLOR: Let's talk about how kind of the week's been for you so far, the first round today, not a bad round one, talk about how you're feeling.

**AMANDA BLUMENHERST:** I played really consistent. I missed a few fairways, but I was able to cut it pretty well and I really only missed hitting one shot. So I was pleased with how I played, a few more putts could go in. I'm happy how the week has been going and the Pro-Am has been a lot of fun and I had some good practice the first few days.

JASON TAYLOR: You made your first cut here as an amateur a few years ago? Does it give you a good feeling just showing up at this place?

**AMANDA BLUMENHERST:** I did. I played the course three years ago, so I had a really good feeling coming into this one. I knew what it was like a little bit except for a few holes. I absolutely love playing here and the fans and the volunteers so I was really looking forward to the Wegmans tournament.

JASON TAYLOR: With these conditions, do you think it's going to be tougher to go low this afternoon or easier?

**AMANDA BLUMENHERST:** Well, the fairways are going to be drying out which will help with length, but it is getting a lot windier which is going to make holding the greens a little bit tougher, and you want to be below the hole on many of these holes.

JASON TAYLOR: Is this like Arizona, hot at all?

**AMANDA BLUMENHERST:** Actually I'm very comfortable. I hear a lot of people saying it's so hot. I didn't really notice until I finished. I'm very comfortable.
