INTERVIEW OF AI MIYAZATO

HEATHER DALY-DONOFRIO: Ai, what a great run you made today in the final round. Can you talk about how you were playing today?

AI MIYAZATO: I mean I played really good. I had many birdie chances out there, and I hit the ball well. I got really strong focus and it was really enjoyable.

HEATHER DALY-DONOFRIO: Questions?

Q. How much are you going to be kicking yourself about that bogey on 18 if it turns out that that would have put you alone in second and let you keep the top ranking, the top spot in the ranking?

AI MIYAZATO: It was a little disappointed in the last hole but I played really good, and I didn't expect that I can shoot 6 or 7-under or something. I played such a good round. I did my job. It just makes me feeling good.

Q. How much was keeping the No. 1 spot on your mind? How much were you motivated by that today?

THE INTERPRETER: I didn't know about that, my status, until this morning, but in the end I think that might have been a good motivator for today's round.

Q. Ai, how impressed are you by how Cristie is playing on this course? I think she is now at 17-under? How amazing, surprised are you about that?

AI MIYAZATO: I mean almost that's too good, I guess. Me and Kenny was talking about earlier this week winning scores going to be maybe 5 to 8-under or so. So she played really, really good and she had such a solid round on her second round, I guess. But she is just amazing. I played really good, too. But she is just better than me.

Q. Ai, when those birdie putts were dropping earlier in your round what were you thinking?

THE INTERPRETER: Earlier in the round today?

Q. Yes, the second and fourth holes.

AI MIYAZATO: Did I have birdie putts on the first few holes? Maybe fourth, 3. I think I made a good putt the first few holes. I had a good opportunity on No. 5, I guess, on the par-5. After that, but I made birdie.

THE INTERPRETER: Up until that hole it didn't feel like I had that many chances.

Q. You started the week with some difficulty and you probably had a lot of distractions this week after taking over the No. 1 spot, how much did that affect your play on Thursday and Friday?

THE INTERPRETER: It wasn't that much on my mind. But now that I'm finished with the week, and I think about it, I probably wasn't able to play my game on the first day. But, you know, even if it's just for one week I was able to get experience, and I will take very many positive things out of it.

Q. Ai, as close as the top rankings are, and they've been, even with the top six players, do you think that's good for the LPGA because it attracts, there is a race on, and it attracts interest in a lot of places such as Japan, America and Korea?

THE INTERPRETER: I think it's very good, and I am very excited to be a part of it. I think it makes it interesting for the fans as well because you never know who could be No. 1 week after week.

Q. Are you playing next week?

AI MIYAZATO: No, I'm going to take a week off next week.

Q. Have you played Oakmont?

AI MIYAZATO: I never played there before. I'm looked forward to it.

Q. What have you heard about it?

AI MIYAZATO: Well, my caddy was telling me that the greens are like potato chips and that it's very difficult.
