AN INTERVIEW WITH BRITTANY LANG

(Interview by tape.)

Q. Can you tell us about the playoff format?

**BRITTANY LANG:** Yes, it was sudden death starting on 17, par-3 and going to 18, par-4. That was the playoff and three birdies. 3 girls out of 6.

Q. Are you looking forward to tomorrow?

**BRITTANY LANG:** I didn't qualify.

Q. Tell us about the format, do you like the change? It had to be exciting today, do you like the format change?

**BRITTANY LANG:** Yes, definitely, especially for the LPGA playoffs, it's a great format. It's unique. We don't get to play this all year. I think it's fun and entertaining for the fans.

Q. Brittany, what sort of emotion shall lift did you get on the way you saved on 16, with the ball in the tree, did you feel at that point like things were going to go your way?

**BRITTANY LANG:** Yes, that was a costly mistake on 15 on my part with a lob-wedge in my hand and making a bogey. I made a good par on 16. I know I needed at least one or two more birdies. I needed at least one. I was fortunate to be in the playoff, we didn't get anything to drop.

Q. To make it this far you had to have a good year, sum up your year, talk about your year in general.

**BRITTANY LANG:** I think we had a great year. It came on strong at the end. I learned so much in the beginning of the year. I'm happy with how I played. I would like to be playing the weekend here but I'm very pleased with my year.

Q. Brittany it was not your typical Friday round on the LPGA, can you talk about how different it is, what you experienced?

**BRITTANY LANG:** Yes, I mean you have to play very aggressively, I think any day out here for this format. You have to play aggressively and go for everything pretty much. If you don't, you know you better be rolling it well, and the putts you don't go for them. I thought it was exciting, exciting format.

Q. A 6 person playoff for three spots?

**BRITTANY LANG:** Yes.

Q. What was that like?

**BRITTANY LANG:** You know, I thought my odds were pretty good, half of the girls are going to get in. I thought I hit a good putt on my first playoff hole. I got it started a little low. I didn't make a very good second stroke on the third one but gave it another chance on 18. But they made 3 good putts and I didn't.

Q. What did you attribute the upswing to the end of your year to?

**BRITTANY LANG:** I just got more comfortable, and I worked on my putting extremely hard. I changed a few things with my putting. And I started putting better than I ever putted in my life. I'm going to stick with those things, yes.
