Third-round tournament quotes

AN INTERVIEW WITH BRANDT SNEDEKER

(Interview by tape.)

Q. How was the finish?

BRANDT SNEDEKER: Nice.

Q. Especially in these conditions, talk to me a little bit.

BRANDT SNEDEKER: Yes, it was great. You know, I hit three birdies coming in was huge. I was hitting it good. I didn't put myself into too much trouble. Then I hit about a foot on that par-5, No. 6, I believe, no, 5.

On 7, I hit a 9-iron in about 20 feet below the hole, and made a good putt.

9 was pure luck. I pulled it off the green, chipped it in and ended the round. So it was a nice way to end the round. Nice way to go in this into the afternoon, but it's playing tough out there. I have to make sure my ball striking stays the same. It's been great the first two days. I want to keep on doing it.

Q. Just historically what kind of a wind player are you?

BRANDT SNEDEKER: I love playing in the wind. I love where the mental aspect of it is so much bigger than anything else. You know there is going to be some good swings where you don't get rewarded. And some bad swings that get punished really hard. So it's going to be a tough grind out there. Now all you have to do is hit a lot of greens, you're not going to hit a lot of fairways, and kind of leave it to people that are not afraid to grind it out and not leave anything out there. That's what I love doing.

Q. Just keep doing?

BRANDT SNEDEKER: Just keep doing the same thing. I've been very

fortunate the first two rounds not to get in any trouble. I would like it the same way for the next two rounds but it's probably not going to happen. There might be some trouble spots the next couple of days, just try to get out of it as quickly as possible, make a few putts. The putter started working good the last six or seven holes. I expect it will be fine. That's all I need.
