### **AN INTERVIEW WITH ERICA BLASBERG**

Q. Even though the way the hole ended, or this round, do you still feel like you're kind of on a roll from the last few weeks?

ERICA BLASBERG: Yes, I do. I'm putting really well right now. I just have to keep it in the fairways and get on the greens when I am making my putts. So, yes, definitely.

Q. Talk about your round today and how it went.

ERICA BLASBERG: Yes, you know, pretty consistent. Front 9, fairways, greens, made a couple of putts.

The back 9 was a little tougher. I was grinding out there. Six holes in a row, I was making like 15 foot par putts.

I will try not to do that tomorrow. It was a pretty good round. I just have a couple of things to improve on which is good.

Q. Must be nice to watch your name move up the leaderboard as you're playing?

ERICA BLASBERG: Yes, I have been waiting for it for a couple of weeks now, so it's nice.

Q. There was a big surge early today, you started off early, and you moved right up the leaderboard, was there something different going today that was different than yesterday?

ERICA BLASBERG: No, again, I'm, just hitting fairways and trying to make some putts out here. Fairways, greens and putts, it's the name of the game out here.

Q. What are the course conditions today compared to yesterday?

ERICA BLASBERG: Yes, no wind today. So it was a little easier. But the greens are still great conditions. The course is so great conditions.

Q. As a non-exempt player, talk about the importance for you to be able to play on the weekends.

ERICA BLASBERG: Yes, I go in each week knowing that I have the potential to have some good finishes out here. I don't really think about it, or put any pressure on it. I go out there and try to make birdies.

Q. So you've got confidence going into your ability going into the weekend?

ERICA BLASBERG: Yes, I definitely do.

Q. What's your approach to Saturday, Sunday?

ERICA BLASBERG: Again, like today, I wasn't hitting fairways on the back 9, so trying to get it in the fairway and making putts. I just try to get it on the green.
