INTERVIEW WITH NATALIE GULBIS

Q. Going into this back 9, you are the leader at 9-under par.

NATALIE GULBIS: Yeah, that pretty much sums it up.

Q. Heading out, how did the course play and just take us through your round on the back 9 as you just finished up.

NATALIE GULBIS: Pretty good green action and a lot of fairways and a lot of greens and had a lot of birdie chances and had one of those easier rounds where I had a good shot and got the birdie.

Q. Even though it's really wet, we talked about being able to throw darts into these holes. You guys can go at a pin that might otherwise be unacceptable.

NATALIE GULBIS: That's great. It's just great because (inaudible).

Q. Do you like these kind of conditions as opposed to being dry and fast?

NATALIE GULBIS: I think you have to learn to like both conditions, when you see a little bit of everything out there, and adjust your game, but you can definitely fire at pins and try to hold that shot.

Q. You've been on the leader board before. What is it going to take you to finally get over that hump? I know you want that allusive first win.

NATALIE GULBIS: Make a lot of birdies.

Q. What are the conditions like out there?

NATALIE GULBIS: Just a little bit wet.

Q. The wetness is obviously a detail. Is it tough to stay focused out there?

NATALIE GULBIS: No, I don't think so. (Inaudible). You are nice and loose out there and just stay clean.

Q. Do you feel like momentum is a little bit on your side now?

NATALIE GULBIS: You just kind of take one shot at a time.
