### AN INTERVIEW WITH HEATHER BOWIE

Heather Bowie, 68-69=137 (-7)

Scorecard: Hole 14, 349-yard par 4: birdie – gap wedge to back fringe, made 30-foot putt

Hole 18, 466-yard par 5: birdie – 4-iron to 15 feet, two-putt

Hole 3, 393-yard par 4: bogey – wedge hit the down slope and went over the green, did not get up and down

Hole 4, 162-yard par 3: birdie – 6-iron left to 30 feet

Hole 6, 478-yard par 5: birdie – 5-iron into bunker, sand wedge to 10 feet

Q. How do you look at Annika's six-shot lead?

HEATHER BOWIE: Six shots is a lot on anyone when you are that far back. I can't do anything. She could very well go out and shoot 64 again tomorrow. All I can do is try and go out there and play better than I played the first two days because I cannot do anything about what she is doing. And six shots is a lot of ground to make up. But, you know, it's been made up by people. I'm not saying it can't be done. I'm not going to concern myself with the six shots.

Q. In a way does it take pressure off of you since she does have a six-shot lead? You can go out there and play your own game and try to make up some ground.

HEATHER BOWIE: Right, absolutely. I think that's the best way to look at it. There is no pressure on me. Or anybody else. I certainly will be more comfortable tomorrow six shots back than I would be one. That's a certainty.

Q. Any speculation about how she will play with that kind of lead?

HEATHER BOWIE: Again, I haven't had a 6-shot lead often. It's been since college. You are almost kind of playing your own tournament then. You are really playing against yourself and the golf course which that is an asset as well. You don't really worry about the competitors. Obviously, she is doing a lot of things well and is going to be quite confident.

Q. Can you talk about the course? It is playing pretty different this year.

HEATHER BOWIE: It is a totally different golf course. You know, it goes from pitching it everywhere, to now you got to run everything up. I mean I played this type of golf better. I play firm, fast golf courses better than I do wet golf courses. Just look at last week. I didn't play very well at all. It was very wet. And I am doing nothing differently this week than I did last week. It is a totally different golf course. And I think it's the different people. Some people are comfortable when it's soft. Some people are comfortable when it's hard.
