## **AN INTERVIEW WITH IAN POULTER**

(Interview by tape.)

Q. Obviously a pink day, and you are a flamboyant person, you wear pink a lot and not many of us do.

**IAN POULTER:** It's a bit strange seeing everybody out there in pink today. It's nice, refreshing. It's nice that everybody else has something pink in their wardrobe
