INTERVIEW OF JIM FURYK

(Interview by tape.)

JIM FURYK: It was right on the front 9. I was 4-under par for the day. And I then played 10, 11, 12, 13, 5-under-par. I was able to birdie 16 on the landing.

Q. The one hole just carried over to the next really?

JIM FURYK: About the time I got my break, my iron shot, the top face of the bunker and shot up underneath the back of the bunker, and I could actually putt it from there to another part of the bunker. I got up and down for bogey. It was a bad break. I made bogey there. I got impatient at 11. I hit it out of the rough, caught the bunker. 12, I hit a short one for par and then hit it in the water on 13. I doubled, it just snowballed on me. I wasn't able to stop the bleeding and I made a bunch of bogeys.

Q. (Inaudible)?

JIM FURYK: If you are going to make a hole-in-one you wouldn't think it would be the back right pin. I was just trying to land something in the middle. If it scooted back there, great. If it didn't, I would putt at it. It had a left right wind. We were trying to land the ball, I think, somewhere in there about 195 yards. It felt like it was playing below 200 yards. I took a 3-iron and kind of choked it up and hit a draw. It held in the wind and came out perfect. It landed right where I wanted to on the plateau. It scooted up the hill. I could see the fans standing up. They must have stood up. The ball was 8 feet short of the hole when they stood up and it kept rolling and rolling, and I figured it got by the hole.
