INTERVIEW OF JOHN SENDEN

(Interview by tape.)

Q. A couple of questions, did you think at the start of the day you would shoot even par and pick up strokes?

JOHN SENDEN: No, it was a pretty windy day, wasn't it? The pins are a bit more tight. Now it will be an interesting day tomorrow. More fun stuff rather than going further ahead.

Q. Good news for you?

JOHN SENDEN: Yes. I mean, I probably feel like I got to get on a bit of a run tomorrow. Pick up a few extra shots tomorrow and knock on the door.

Q. When you see a guy go out and shoot a couple of 62's, a 7-shot lead, for the rest of the field, can you play kind of loose knowing that this guy has all of the pressure?

JOHN SENDEN: Yes, you know, it's hard enough backing up 62 once, and to do it again, he done it well. On this golf course you need to be precise. You have to have ball striking and putting to shoot a great score. I think the wind was an issue today. Shooting par and picking up ground was hard. It's not a bad thing around here. Springtime in Texas is always going to be windy. You know, go out there and do your job and see what happens at the end of the day.

Q. Really. Tomorrow now it's anybody's game. You only need to pick up a few shots and you are right there, right?

JOHN SENDEN: Yes, I mean I have to do what I do best and play my game and go out there and be calm and do my job well. Hit great shots. I have to play very, very well tomorrow if I'm going to get it done. If I can do that and try to get it done.

Q. Do you like this course?

JOHN SENDEN: Yes, it's a home game for us to. We live about 40 minutes up the road so we see a lot of people from Flower Mound and Bridlewood. You know, it's a fun tournament for us and Colonial Country Club really looks after me as well. They let me come down here any time and play and it's a fun golf course to play.

Q. You live in Flower Mound now?

JOHN SENDEN: Yes. Yes, it's not a home game, but it's a home game.
