QUICK QUOTES FROM JEFF QUINNEY

Q. You had a bogey free round today. Talk a little bit about the round and the course.

JEFF QUINNEY: I was off to an early start. It was dead dark when I got here. We basically didn't see the first hole until we teed off. The wind was kind of calm to start the day and got tough at the end. Greens got a little crusty, and the wind was a little bit of a factor. But the game and chipping and putting and just trying to score it. Even though I didn't hit a lot of perfect shots today, but just got it in the hole.

Q. What time did the wind start becoming a factor?

JEFF QUINNEY: I would say like the 9th hole. Kind of coming hard off on the left on the 9th, probably around 9:00 a.m. You know the greens, definitely some tough pins out there. You

know, par 5s are kind of -- the wind's helping you a little bit too. Got to take advantage of it.

Q. Now 18 has been playing pretty tough today. You got a birdie on there.

JEFF QUINNEY: I laid it out to 62 yards and a little into the wind. I spun it back too much. Was fortunate to make a little 15-footer to kind of keep the momentum and take advantage of those par 5s. You feel like you should play those a couple under.
