### **AN INTERVIEW WITH K.J. CHOI**

**JOAN vT ALEXANDER:** Thank you, K.J. for joining us for a few minutes in the media center at the PODS Championship. A nice round today, a great position going into tomorrow and Sunday.

**INTERPRETTER:** I'm getting a little better every day. My scores are getting better. 2-under, 2-under, first two days. The weather was very good today and I just felt generally real comfortable out there.

**JOAN vT ALEXANDER:** Questions?

**Q.** Can you talk about the difference in the course today compared to yesterday, it seemed the pin placements were easier, a little more accessible?

**INTERPRETTER:** Actually, I don't think it was that easy today. I think some players probably had a difficult time out there. The pin positions on some holes were very, very difficult. But I think overall the greens were a lot softer today and that's probably why you see a lot of low scores out there.

**Q.** One more round of maybe 68 does it?

**K.J. CHOI:** I don't know.

**INTERPRETTER:** Tomorrow is going to be the last day, everybody is going to be going for the pin. I'm just going to not think about anything, just, you know, let my swing do the talking, and just try to be real comfortable out there and just not be too greedy.

**Q.** Is the success that you've had here kind of give you a little bit of comfort to take into tomorrow because this place has been very good to you?

**INTERPRETTER:** Yes, you know, I really feel comfortable with the course because it kind of reminds me of Korea, where a lot of courses in Korea are located on the mountainside, so therefore a lot of the holes you are looking down from the tee box. And even the driving range here, you know, the players you are looking down. And given the first tee, the 10th tee, everybody is looking down. So it sort of reminds me of

the slopes in Korea and that's what makes me feel comfortable out there.

Q. What was the best part of K.J.'s game today?

**INTERPRETTER:** I think it was chipping and putting. The sixth hole was really the turn around today.
