**AN INTERVIEW WITH CANDIE KUNG**

THE MODERATOR: Awesome round of 64. Some opening comments.

CANDIE KUNG: I had a very good day today out there. Putts were going in. Some of them were going in. I think I hit pretty much everything. I missed the first fairway and that was it. Pretty consistent all day.

THE MODERATOR: We will do your card.

CANDIE KUNG: Yes. Birdied 4, par-5. I hit in there in two, 2-putted. I hit a 5-wood. The first putt was from the front of the green. So that was like 45 meet maybe. It's got to be more than that.

5, a par-4. What's 5? Yes, I hit an 8-iron from 146 yards to about a foot, a little tap in.

No. 9, I had 132. I hit an 8-iron to just barely short of the green and putted. That one was about 8 yards. 8 yards, 24 feet.

No. 11, I hit 127, and I hit a 9-iron. I hit a 9-iron to about 20 feet.

12, 122 yards, I hit a 9-iron to about 15 feet.

14, I had 137 to the hole. I hit to about ten feet.

16, I had 119 for my third shot, hit a 9-iron to about 12 feet.

18, I had 95 yards, hit a little pitching wedge to a foot.

Q. Did you see Heather making birdies earlier and figured you needed to kick it in gear to start making birdies to keep up?

CANDIE KUNG: No, I was pretty much out there playing my own game. It's only the third day. I didn't look at the scoreboard at all until 18. When I looked up, I'm like wow, it's a pretty good day for every one, not just me.

But the course is not playing that difficult right now because of the rain. We are able to just fire at the pin and the ball is not going anywhere. The wind is not really blowing a whole lot out there.

So the course, if can you keep it in play, it's not that difficult.

Q. A career low round, it's got to be fun to play a low round and make a lot of birdies down there?

CANDIE KUNG: Yes, I had a lot of birdies, had a lot of them close. A few of them I didn't read it right. But most of them, I had a good putt with it. Very confident with it.

Q. I think you played here in the AJGA Tournament, do you remember that far back?

CANDIE KUNG: Yes, I remember I had a hole-in-one on No. 8. No. 8, the pin was left front corner. I couldn't see it. I couldn't see it.

Q. What's the outlook for tomorrow? Obviously it's going to be the same kind of scoring, a big shootout tomorrow?

CANDIE KUNG: Right. Hopefully the weather will get a little warmer and just have to go out there and hit fairway and greens, putts going in. I'll be all right.

Q. With cool weather, how much do you have to adjust yardages or is it that big of a factor?

CANDIE KUNG: For me it's about 5 to 7 yards shorter for every club. I always try to figure that out the first or second hole.

Q. You do that early in the round?

A. Yes, early in the round.
