**AN INTERVIEW WITH LORENA OCHOA**

(Interview by tape.)

Q. Can you tell us what it means to make it through the playoffs?

**LORENA OCHOA:** Well, I didn't want to go play 18 again. It would be easier. Juli made that putt and putt extra pressure on me. But I had a pretty good line, because I seen that direction before. And I made it. It was just an exciting moment and relief because it's a hard job during these two days.

Q. How far was the putt on 17, the birdie putt?

**LORENA OCHOA:** Maybe 15 feet.

Q. Talk about you are not used to having this kind of pressure Friday afternoon, talk about what it was like to do?

**LORENA OCHOA:** We are used to more pressure, the more we are in, the more times we play in this situation, and it just makes you a better player. So all of this is a learning experience, and I am sure that playing this playoff today, and just trying so hard on the back 9 to get in the playoff, was a really good challenge. But at the same time I learn a lot. It's going to be good for my game later. So I'm just really happy that I'm going to be able to play tomorrow and I'm going to do my best tomorrow again.

Q. How difficult will that be tomorrow, you were out of the 16 going into today, made up that ground, do it again tomorrow, how tough will that be?

**LORENA OCHOA:** I don't want to think on numbers, the other players, I'm going to come here and do my own game. I think a good round will do it, 3 or 4-under. I'm going to be aggressive because I have nothing to lose.

Q. Would it be safe to say you like the playoff format?

**LORENA OCHOA:** I'm doing it so I like it. It is fun. I think it's something different and I have to not be wrong. I always support the LPGA in the way we play. It's a new experience.

Q. It looks like you won when you made that putt over there?

**LORENA OCHOA:** Yes, it felt really good. My birdie on 16 in regular round and birdie on 17 felt really good.

Q. Talk about (Inaudible)?

**LORENA OCHOA:** I think that was the key, if I were to make that birdie I was out of the competition. It feels good when you have to do it, and it was one of those do shots. And I hit a perfect 8-iron just close to the pin, and I'm just glad it turned my way.
