## AN INTERVIEW WITH LINDSEY WRIGHT

Q. Where do you think you finally settled into your round today, got to a groove and shot low today? Where did you start to pick up the round?

**LINDSEY WRIGHT:** I actually started very well today. I was 3-under after five holes. I played the front 9 really well, so I had good momentum going into the back 9. I had good momentum going into the back 9. I started off well. I felt like probably the start of the round, which usually you get to the middle, or towards the end of the round, your momentum picks up. But I just didn't make as many putts on the back 9. I hit some poor putts on the back 9. All in all, it was solid day

Q. Nice to play uninterrupted for weather and everything?

**LINDSEY WRIGHT:** Yes, it is. It was a beautiful day today. I couldn't have asked for better weather.

JASON TAYLOR: How long was it for the two days, all of the delays that we had?

**LINDSEY WRIGHT:** It wasn't too bad. Yesterday I was a late tee-off anyhow. And I was the first to tee-off in the afternoon. So I teed off at 5. I managed to play 16 holes on Friday, and to come back this morning at 5 to finish three holes, and then I went back to my hotel and had to sleep for an hour before coming out to play today. So for me it wasn't too bad. There are some girls that are playing 30 holes today, nearly 36 holes really, so it's going to be tough on them.

Q. You had your career best finish earlier this month, how happy are you with where your game is right now?

**LINDSEY WRIGHT:** I'm really happy. I'm in a good place. To start the season I think every player will tell you to do well at the start of the season, it takes a lot of pressure off as far as getting into certain events. You kind of establish a good momentum from just playing well, and you've got something to draw upon

throughout the season and that's where I feel like this year I've done really well. I started well and I've built from it rather than started poorly and kind of being lost. I built from the good shots and played well in some really good events.

Q. You mentioned before that you kind of use positive preparation before a game, what does that entail?

**LINDSEY WRIGHT:** Just mental preparation, visualizing the shots before you go out and play, visualizing before you play a round of golf, seeing what holes are difficult to play and kind of playing them in your mind before you go out to play. It's almost like you're prepared when you get there. It's not a surprise. It takes the edge off of it. So that's really helped me this year. My mental preparation has improved before the round.
