**AN INTERVIEW WITH BRITTANY LINCICOME**

(Interview by tape.)

BRITTANY LINCICOME: Is.

Q. 7-under today?

BRITTANY LINCICOME: Yes.

Q. How excited are you?

BRITTANY LINCICOME: Very. Finally playing the way that I wanted to play. All year I just get too excited the first round. I want to be like 10-under the first day and it just doesn't happen like that. So I was trying to work on -- this golf course for some reason sets up really good for me. The driver, I haven't really missed a fairway which helps.

Q. You are known for your long drives, as far as length, and accuracy too, you have been right on this week?

BRITTANY LINCICOME: I have. Every shot I've set up to, I know it's going to go straight. A couple of the holes that I should have hit 5-wood, because I got too close to the green, I know the driver is going dead straight, so I don't want to veer away too much from that. Just keep it in and just have that 50 yard shot to the green.

Q. How many fairways did you hit today?

BRITTANY LINCICOME: All but 2. I missed one yesterday.

Q. Coming down the back nine, the wind picking up, did that affect your focus at all?

BRITTANY LINCICOME: Not too bad actually. The last three holes it got confusing. This last hole, I wanted to hit the 4-iron, but I didn't want to be in the water. I had to go in that bunker again.

Q. Just going over your day to day, some highlights of the day?

BRITTANY LINCICOME: Just today?

Q. Yes.

BRITTANY LINCICOME: Maybe the birdies. Playing with Christina, too. I haven't played with her all year. That was exciting and making the birdies.

Q. Can you go over your scorecard, you had a birdie on 6?

BRITTANY LINCICOME: Yes. Do you know what par it is?

Q. Par was 5. Birdie on 6, you had a 4. What club did you use coming in to the green?

BRITTANY LINCICOME: I think a driving iron. I think that was a long one, wasn't it?

Q. Was that the 504 yards?

BRITTANY LINCICOME: Yes.

Q. On your third shot, how many yards out were you from the green?

BRITTANY LINCICOME: 200.

Q. You used your driving iron?

BRITTANY LINCICOME: Yes.

Q. From 200, how close was that putt?

BRITTANY LINCICOME: I actually hit it in the bunker. The next one was like five feet.

Q. Out of the bunker you used a sand wedge?

BRITTANY LINCICOME: Lob wedge.

Q. Lob wedge to five feet?

BRITTANY LINCICOME: Yes.

Q. And then on 7.

BRITTANY LINCICOME: I have no idea. Hold on, let me get my book. What hole was it, 7?

Q. Yes.

BRITTANY LINCICOME: 7, I hit a 9-iron to 130 yards. That was kind of a long one, that was kind of 15 feet.

Q. Okay.

BRITTANY LINCICOME: Nancy hit the same birdie putt before me, so I got the read on it.

Q. Then on number 9?

BRITTANY LINCICOME: We were 144 yards to the pin, I hit an 8 -iron.

Q. For a double eagle?

BRITTANY LINCICOME: Yes.

Q. 16?

BRITTANY LINCICOME: Did I have a birdie on 16?

Q. Yes.

BRITTANY LINCICOME: 16, I had 83 yards and I hit the lob wedge to six feet.

Q. 17?

BRITTANY LINCICOME: 17, was 135, I hit a 9-iron to like 30 feet.

Q. Very nice. 18?

BRITTANY LINCICOME: 18, I hit it in that bunker, lob wedge back bunker to seven feet.

Q. This is your second year on tour, can you go over this year versus last year?

BRITTANY LINCICOME: This year is a lot easier just because I know the courses. I know like the travel and all of that. I know a lot of the girls which is easy. It's easier. Just knowing the courses really, I think is a lot of help.

Q. Anything you worked on particularly in the off season, or that you have been working on?

BRITTANY LINCICOME: I am not hitting the ball left. All last year, my miss was left on left. The control, normally in trouble. This year I haven't hit the ball left at all which has made a world of difference. I know setting up to it, it's not going to go left, work on that.

Q. Any plans for tomorrow then?

BRITTANY LINCICOME: No, no, maybe try to do the same thing, keep giving myself chances and see what happens.

Q. Any goals for tomorrow, any scores you're aiming for?

BRITTANY LINCICOME: Anything under par, 1-under par would make me happy. I have never been in that situation.

Q. Thank you so much.

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
