INTERVIEW OF MARK WILSON

(by press room.)

On his chances heading into the final round...

"I feel good about my chances. I would have liked to have made that last birdie putt (on 18) that was about six feet that I just didn't hit hard enough, but I'm excited for tomorrow. Anything can happen."

On closing in on David Toms and the lead...

"I played with David the first two days and he was so in control, but that's golf for you. You get some bad breaks or the putts stop rolling in, and the next thing you know, it's snowballing the wrong direction. I saw it roll in the right direction for him, though, the first two days with two 62s!"

On the conditions...

"The greens are a little firmer, so it's a little bit tougher, but still similar to Thursday. The wind was a big factor early, but on the last three holes after the delay, there wasn't much wind out there."

"You have to come out and play well, especially now that everyone's come back to the pack. You just need to go out there, shoot a low one and post something. It's still anybody's ballgame."
