**AN INTERVIEW WITH MICHELLE ESTILL**

MICHELLE ESTILL: You know, it's been a couple of weeks since I played. I didn't play much when I was off. I played well today, made a lot of putts. The greens here are awesome. So that was fun. I'm looking forward to tomorrow, it will be fun. I get to play in the morning. I'm playing with a great group, so looking forward to it.

Q. (Inaudible)?

MICHELLE ESTILL: Well, you never know. If we had anymore delay we might not finish today. That would have been a disadvantage. I have had a couple of bad ones this year, so it kind of all works out at the end of the year.

Q. How close was the putt there?

MICHELLE ESTILL: Close. I thought it was going in. It just hit the edge. I thought it was breaking a little right. I managed to hit it hard enough, I was concentrating on that. I got excited there for a minute.

Q. (Inaudible)?

MICHELLE ESTILL: Exactly. It was slowing down faster. Exactly.

Q. Good luck tomorrow.

MICHELLE ESTILL: Thanks.

Q. Any memorable career shots out there, anything we should know about?

MICHELLE ESTILL: I will tell you, I putted great. I had a couple of putts that I thought was going in. I didn't hit it. I didn't do anything spectacular. I made some putts, and I hit some good solid irons. They were pretty consistent and on line. Pretty consistent flight path than I normally have, so that was different. Overall it was just a solid round. I made the putts when I wanted to.

DANA GROSS-RHODE: Start on the back.

MICHELLE ESTILL: I hit a 3-wood, and I hit a 9-iron to 15 feet made that putt.

DANA GROSS-RHODE: How far out were you?

MICHELLE ESTILL: 146, I hit an 8-iron.

DANA GROSS-RHODE: No. 14, par-3.

MICHELLE ESTILL: I made a 5-iron, 183. And I hit it 25 feet.

DANA GROSS-RHODE: 15.

MICHELLE ESTILL: I hit it's 141, I hit an 8-iron, I was in between clubs, I hit it five feet.

DANA GROSS-RHODE: 16.

MICHELLE ESTILL: I hit my drive-in the trees. I tried to get it up over and it came down short in that tree, short in the right, up on the hill, like right down in the root system of it. I punched it up and got up and down for a bogey. Made about an eight-foot putt for bogey.

DANA GROSS-RHODE: So were you chipping onto the green.

MICHELLE ESTILL: Yes, short, I had to chop it out from there, underneath the tree and chipped it from there.

DANA GROSS-RHODE: 2.

MICHELLE ESTILL: 2, I hit 146 with an 8-iron and left it 4 feet.

DANA GROSS-RHODE: 6.

MICHELLE ESTILL: 146 with an 8. And I hit that, it was a pretty good putt about ten feet.

8, 136, I hit 9. I made about a 12-footer. I got off to a good start, and I made a good putt. In Rochester I putted really well. I've been putt well. It rolled great for me.

Nothing spectacular. I had a new driver in my bag, that was it. Just my game, it's a ball striking golf course. The greens are fast. I'm looking forward to tomorrow where it will be smoother. Just give myself a chance. It was obviously wet. I don't think it played much difference.
