AN INTERVIEW WITH NATALIE GULBIS

MIKE SCANLAN: Natalie, thanks for coming in.

NATALIE GULBIS: Thank you.

them in such good shape.

NATALIE GULBIS: It's been a great year and another highlight of the year was definitely winning the Solheim Cup with my U.S. team over in Sweden.

NATALIE GULBIS: Good, good. I actually just got back from playing in the ADT skills up in my Miami, and we had fun down there. It will be nice getting in the role of playing in some competitive events again.

Q. Talk about who you played with in the ADT, and you guys actually won it?

NATALIE GULBIS: Yes. We actually won the ADT skills, and my partner was John Elway. It's a fun made for TV event, raised different challenges, and I was excited too. Because I was the only LPGA female player there in the 8 person shoot out. We had an absolute blast.

NATALIE GULBIS: The golfer, not even close. But I like the other one too because I've really enjoyed being part of the show. It's fun. It really is a shoot, because they're shooting my life away from the golf course. Then it's fun to get the feedback from fans and friends about the show and about moments that have occurred while the camera has been going.

NATALIE GULBIS: Not that I noticed. The ones that are intimidated I have not met. I have a lot of friends that are male players and golf has been really great for me business-wise, because I have had a lot of individuals in the business world that I have had an opportunity to play with and pick their brains. Everybody plays golf.

I learned that again this week when I was with the [ex|ex-]-professional football players, these quarterbacks, they love playing golf. Roger Clemens was there. He loves golf. Jerry Rice, these players, everybody loves golf, so it's fun to play with a whole bunch of different personalities.

NATALIE GULBIS: Oh, big time impressed. Craig and I were actually talking about it on the range this morning, and to be that many under par is amazing. She has had a fantastic year, and we're all very proud of her and what she has continued to play well.
