**Interview of Liselotte Neumann**

**THE MODERATOR:** Great playing today 64, 11-under for the tournament, and 9 birdies for the day.

**LISELOTTE NEUMANN:** Yeah. I played extremely good today. Actually it could have been even better. A couple of mistakes, a couple of missed short putts. Overall probably one of my best ball striking days, I think, in a long time.

**LISELOTTE NEUMANN:** Yeah, I think I have been playing good. And even like last week in Los Angeles, I had a really good round, but I couldn't really -- it's been coming from distance like for me either really good or I make stupid mistakes. And it's been kind of been the same even this week to do a lot of stuff even yesterday, six birdies and I shot 1-under par. I'm giving a lot of shots back. So missing a couple of short putts and a wedge, I missed and a couple of drives yesterday, but today, overall, I mean, you know, you have (inaudible).

**Q (Inaudible)?**

**LISELOTTE NEUMANN:** Trying to just relax in between. I put a good swing on it and took the aim at the target and at the flag. Yeah trying to be as relaxed as we could.

**LISELOTTE NEUMANN:** Yeah, I think, so it was disappointing to get the chance to represent Europe over there, but you know there's nothing I can do about it so.

**LISELOTTE NEUMANN:** No, I don't think so. I talked to Catrina, she knew I was playing well, she just felt I shouldn't be part of the match-play event. She knows I'm a good stroke player, tournament player. I don't feel like I have to prove anything. I feel like I'm having a good year.

**LISELOTTE NEUMANN:** It was a little windy, not too bad. The greens are holding up pretty good. The course is not playing too long. Give yourself a lot of birdie opportunities out there.

**Q (Inaudible)**

**LISELOTTE NEUMANN:** Some of the holes are a little tight, but it's pretty generous off the tee. (inaudible) drivers pretty much on every hole. It may be like two holes where I have a 7-wood or 4-wood. And other than that I feel confident with my driver and driving it pretty much everywhere.

**Q (Inaudible) part of the final group what is your mindset being in that situation?**

**LISELOTTE NEUMANN:** I think it's pretty much the same as any other day. Obviously I probably feel the nerves a little more on the final day. But overall it's, you know, you really can't change your game plan too much. You know, I think for me it's go out there and strike the ball as good as I can, and not try to be too conservative, just take dead aim and start out good. You feel like you get the confidence and then you can just go -- (inaudible)
