INTERVIEW WITH LISELOTTE NEUMANN

LISELOTTE NEUMANN: It's a little bit of a challenge (inaudible) because I didn't play that great yesterday, and I was even par and nothing was really happening out there. So I don't think it really affected me either way, actually, to be honest.

Q. That makes sense. (Inaudible)?

LISELOTTE NEUMANN: Absolutely, it's great. It's good to see a lot of people coming out here, and it's going to be tough for them to cross that creek down there.

Q. You went over in a cart, is that right?

A. Yes, yes.

Q. How was it for you? A little scary?

LISELOTTE NEUMANN: Well, coming up here, there is

actually water going back through the course and you have to put your feet up. Yes, it's really high. There was water coming in the cart. It's pretty high. I don't know if it will get any higher or not.

Q. Well, I'm not sure. (Inaudible)?

LISELOTTE NEUMANN: (Inaudible) I think yesterday, you know, it was kind of questioning whether to continue to play, but thank goodness they had this thing in place, because I don't think we could play today either because it's really muddy out there, and they were smart to think ahead on that. So they did a great job.

Q. And what do you do this round to stay focus, or are you able to?
