AN INTERVIEW WITH LORENA OCHOA

LORENA OCHOA: No, it's working. I have some things, that's okay. You can't always win. (Inaudible). That will help. I am hoping to get that trophy.

LORENA OCHOA: Go for it. I really enjoy playing golf and. I'm having a good time myself. Hopefully keep it going the same.

Q. How do the greens compare here to what you face at Newport next week?

LORENA OCHOA: That would be good preparation for The Open. Tight fairways. The greens are really small. They are downhill, uphill. Just big breaks, especially short putts. That's good preparation. I'm ready to go for next week.
