Final-round Interview

### AN INTERVIEW OF ROD PAMPLING

**THE MODERATOR:** All right. We thank Rod Pampling for stopping. You finished the tournament at 10-under. A hard fought battle today, Rod, and some trouble there over the last four holes.

**ROD PAMPLING:** Oh, yeah, it was trouble on 16. The green I missed all day today. It was unfortunate that we didn't get the third shot, which obviously led to the double. But on the whole I hit the ball great, I just didn't make the putts.

**THE MODERATOR:** We'll go straight to questions.

**Q** What options did you have on your third shot on 15?

**ROD PAMPLING:** Basically I didn't have much. I had like a lip on the concrete there, so when I first started off I thought we could just putt it up there, because it was quite thin grass. But once I got there I could see the lip of the concrete. So I virtually took that play out, which I had to try and get it in the air, and that's why it come across so fast.

**Q** Did you think you could get relief from over there? I know were you talking --

**ROD PAMPLING:** I wasn't too sure. Just in the heat of the battle, I just called for a ruling just to see what we could get out of it. If we could get something. I kind of figured once I had called him and had a look at it myself, the only way I could do was to go backwards and that is what they said.

**Q** (Inaudible)?

**ROD PAMPLING:** It was only because the bush was there. So I really didn't have an option.

**Q** With your second shot what club did you use?

**ROD PAMPLING:** 6-iron.

**Q** Talk about the putt on 18, what you saw.

**ROD PAMPLING:** We saw it was just outside left. I just hit the ball too hard. I realized it was downhill and the last thing you want to do is leave it short. We brought it in a little bit on the edge, and it stayed there. It didn't turn at all until it was past the hole, but we had to give it the go.

**Q** Before the 15th hole were you feeling good about the way you were playing.

**ROD PAMPLING:** Yeah, I hadn't missed a green. Oh, I missed on the par 3. But I was hitting the shots where I wanted to. I was driving it great. You know, it was one of those deals. It happens a lot. You miss one green and you make the big number, unfortunately it happened today

**Q** Rod you went through 15, 16, 17 and 18, was there any difference being in your hometown versus when you are going through it in another city or not?

**ROD PAMPLING:** Not at that stage. At that stage you are focused on what you are doing out there. I was just hoping for a bit of local luck. Unfortunately it didn't come.

**Q** (Inaudible) Tim made some pretty good putts coming in?

**ROD PAMPLING:** Those were two huge putts he made coming down the stretch. He played great all day as well. It's one of those golf courses. You can play great, all of a sudden you are staring down the barrel of a 10-foot of a par real quick. And to his credit he made both of those big putts, so.
