## AN INTERVIEW WITH SANDRA GAL

Q. You are usually accurate off the tee?

**SANDRA GAL:** Yes, I'm pretty straight, yes.

Q. That was a bad spell?

**SANDRA GAL:** Yes, it just happens, that's golf.

Q. Any change in the way the course played today with more water on it today, or was it pretty much the same again?
