INTERVIEW OF SONG-HEE KIM

HEATHER DALY-DONOFRIO: Song-Hee, congratulations on a tremendous tournament. Can you talk a little bit about how you played today?

**SONG-HEE KIM:** First, thanks for having me. My thing was pretty nice day. I had a lot of birdie, especially on No. 11. That was a big putt for me.

HEATHER DALY-DONOFRIO: You have finished in the Top-10 eleven out of your last 12 tournaments and still looking for that first victory. Do you feel that your game is coming along to win a tournament soon?

**SONG-HEE KIM:** Yes, I keep trying hard to be win. I think before I try more good shot or good birdie, I probably can win.

HEATHER DALY-DONOFRIO: Questions?

Q. How much does it help you to have a round like this in the final round of a Major? How much does it help your confidence going forward?

**THE INTERPRETER:** Well, of course, this being a Major tournament it certainly gives me more confidence and an added boost in my game to have a round like this today. This week, the course was extremely difficult and having been able to finish the way I did on such a difficult course it definitely is a confident booster.

Q. It was mentioned the Top-10 finishes, 11 of 12, whatever, why so consistent? What's the thing that provides that consistency week after week of being right there?

**THE INTERPRETER:** You know, always week in and week out I try to stay consistent with everything, whether it's my practice rounds to go out and play the rounds, the tournament, whatever it is that I'm

doing, I don't try to change anything a whole lot and just try to stay with my routine, and I think that's why it's showing in my consistent performance this year, whether it's mentally, physically, game-wise, just staying consistent, that's what I have been doing.

Q. How did you feel like the golf course set up for your game this week?

**SONG-HEE KIM:** Harder than last year. I missed cut two years in a row, the last two years.

**THE INTERPRETER:** It was such a difficult course. Obviously as Song-Hee said much more difficult this year than it has in the past, but I really wanted to play well in this tournament this year.

Q. Just coming into the final round and Cristie being so far ahead, what kind of mindset is there when winning is probably not going to be within anyone's reach?

**SONG-HEE KIM:** Forget about her, her round. She is too far away. I only try consistent today.

**THE INTERPRETER:** I didn't think too much about where Cristie was, and I tried to clear my mind and tried to have the best game that I can and I think that's one of the reasons why I had a good round today.
