AN INTERVIEW WITH SEON-HWA LEE

(Interview by tape.)

Q. You must feel good how you played?

SEON-HWA LEE: Yes, I had a great day. My drive shot was good, but I missed, three or four time I missed the fairway, but my iron shot was good, good yardage into the green all day long. So I had a lot of birdie chance. My putting was great today. I had a great round today.

Q. Do you feel like it's something you can build ongoing into the rest of the tournament?

SEON-HWA LEE: Yes, two weeks ago I practice a lot of times. I practice short game a lot. I have this week, I fix the swing a little bit.

Q. You've had a very good year, and this is a very exclusive event, are you pretty excited to be in an event like this, a 20 player field, the Top-20 players in the world as a rookie?

SEON-HWA LEE: Yes, sure, because I didn't miss the cut this year so I can play this week. Yes, I think it's a great year.

Q. Sure. Can you walk me through your round, the third, what club did you hit into that, into the green?

SEON-HWA LEE: I think I had 213.

Q. 213 you had left?

SEON-HWA LEE: Yes.

Q. What club?

SEON-HWA LEE: A 5-wood.

Q. How long was the putt?

SEON-HWA LEE: I hit 30 yard chip shot.

Q. No. 3. We just want to run through the birdies and bogeys and see what she hit and what the yardages were.

SEON-HWA LEE: 45.

Q. 45 to the hole?

SEON-HWA LEE: Yes.

Q. Pitch shot 45 yards. Okay.

No. 7.

THE CADDY: 7, third shot was 62, eight feet, 56 degree.

Q. No. 9?

THE CADDY: 202 hole, 4 hybrid, 205, 25 feet.

SEON-HWA LEE: Maybe 20.

THE CADDY: 20 feet.

Q. No. 12?

THE CADDY: 60 to the hole?

Q. 56 again?

THE CADDY: Yes, to two feet.

Q. And you had a bogey on 13?

THE CADDY: Pulled 5-wood?

SEON-HWA LEE: 30 on the left

THE CADDY: That would be part of the pull. It road the wind just a hair.

Q. No. 14, birdie there?

THE CADDY: 14 was 164 to the hole. 4-iron to two feet.

Q. What did you do on 18?

THE CADDY: 18 was a par.

Q. Okay. All right. Excellent. Thank you both very much.
