AN INTERVIEW WITH SE RI PAK

INTERVIEWER: Se Ri, for as windy as it was out there, what are your thoughts? You still stayed 1-under par. You are still in the lead. You've got to be thinking pretty positive going into tomorrow.

SE RI PAK: Pretty positive. I feel great. I'm very happy to finish the way I finished today. I did 2-under today. It's so difficult out there today. The wind is really hard, and every second it changes. So it's pretty hard to decide what club you are going to use. Really difficult. And on the greens, same way. Just not easy. It's a lot of tough situations out there, but I have a still really solid round today, and I missed a couple of shots, but just always happens in the game, but it's no change. I feel really great.

INTERVIEWER: Can we go over your scorecard quick. Bogie on 2.

SE RI PAK: No. 2, I hit 7-iron, about 30 feet. I make a 3-putt. Actually, my first putt, about around 4 feet, and I missed that putt. So it makes it 3-putt, and I make first birdie on 4. I had a pretty good tee shot, and second shot, I had 8-iron, about 30 feet again. It was 30 foot. It was a pretty solid putt.

INTERVIEWER: 6

SE RI PAK: No. 6, I hit 8-iron, about 12 feet. Yeah, I make birdie.

INTERVIEWER: 13.

SE RI PAK: 13, I got my wedge, about 7, 8 feet, birdie.

INTERVIEWER: 16.

SE RI PAK: 16 I hit a really perfect tee shot, and then I got the winds really picking up, down and left and right. I don't know what's going on

out there, but I did miss a shot there. I used my wedge and it caught a tree on the right side and just straight down from under the tree. So I just didn't get up and down to make a bogie there.

INTERVIEWER: When you got to the green, what did you do on the green there?

SE RI PAK: 2-putt there. On 18, 3-wood, about 25, 30 yards. 35 yards, I guess, and then driven down there for 4 feet, 5 feet and birdie.

INTERVIEWER: Okay. Questions?

Q. Did you watch the leaderboard? Were you aware that Morgan in particular was climbing up on you there?

SE RI PAK: Yes, I saw it a couple of times, yes. I know she got a pretty good round today. It's pretty much a surprise. The weather out there, it's really hard. A lot of things. Nobody is going to get really low, but she did. Must be she really hot putter she has, or I don't know what she had, but really, very, very surprised.

Q. You talked yesterday about especially being in the lead, playing not to make too many mistakes. What mistakes did you make today? Do you remember certain spots?

SE RI PAK: Actually, first putt I make a 3-putt. That's about it. From the fairway, I missed a shot here and there a couple of times. Usually it happens in this kind of conditions. Today I wasn't as much make too much mistake. One pulled left. The driver go completely up and down, was up and down on No. 7, and that's about it. What I don't like about it today was No. 2. I make a 3-putt, not too far away from the hole. Just make a 3-putt. That's kind of not a great start, but anyway, at the end, I hung in there really well and I have a really great solid round.

Q. Did you hear about In-Kyung Kim making the seven birdies in a row?

SE RI PAK: No. I know she is going really low.

Q. She made seven birdies in a row, her first seven.

SE RI PAK: She did good.

Q. Have you heard of that happening recently at all?

SE RI PAK: No, not at all, because when I go out to the golf course, you don't hear it. You are only hearing the gallery is having fun out there. That's probably all you are hearing, but not who is making the birdie, how many in a row or making whatever, but it's good. Some girls out there, especially in the lead, is young players. They have some game.

Q. She finished the first nine with a 27.

SE RI PAK: Oh, that's pretty good.

Q. She actually said that you're one of her inspirations. You are one of the people that he watched on TV and helped make her want to get into golf

and become a professional golfer.

SE RI PAK: Today, my partner, she played In-Kyung. She did the same thing. She saw me ten years ago. She was like in high school, and somehow she was watching my game. I was playing in Korea, and she said Hi to me, and I said Hi to her. She was so excited about it, and she tell me about those things. But she said, just because of me, she play golf, and she was saying that I'm her idol. So that's pretty special for me, when I play with the young players out there, because they start playing golf because of me, and we are in the same tour players. That was pretty neat. So it was kind of a little, you know, special. It was cute.

Q. Have you played with Morgan before, and what do you think of her game, Morgan Pressel?

SE RI PAK: Actually, I don't really play much with her. So I don't see much of her game, but I know she has a really great short game. So it would be like today; she got pretty great putting all day long because she is making a bunch of birdies out there, which is pretty good. I know she is great player. I don't know how far she hit it, but I know she is a good player. She won her first major, which that's pretty good for a young age. Tomorrow is very exciting.

Q. You've won big by a lot of shots; you also won close in playoffs. I'm just wondering, tomorrow, what do you think you have to do?

SE RI PAK: Well, I don't think I have to do anything; just play like I'm playing the last three days. I mean, my game is very solid enough to be out there and play just comfortably. So tomorrow is the same way. I'm not trying to make too much mistake; just trying one shot at a time and hopefully trying to enjoy it all day long, and I just hope to see all the fans out there, and so hopefully on 18 I can take my glove off and hold the trophy in my hand. That would be really great.
