AN INTERVIEW WITH TIGER WOODS

(Interview by tape.)

Q. So are you cold and miserable?

TIGER WOODS: I'm pretty cold right now. It was a little wet and a little cold coming in.

Q. (Inaudible)?

TIGER WOODS: It's been a while.

Q. Tiger, what was your attitude coming in today's round? What did you hope to accomplish?

TIGER WOODS: Well, I just try to hit the ball solid, and give myself some putts at it. And I drove it great today. I hit it pretty great, and I hit my irons just terrible. And I just couldn't shake anything, even on the greens either. I just had a hard time on the greens.

Q. All of us were surprised when that rain hit, what was it like to play, you're cold, you probably didn't have any feeling in your hands?

TIGER WOODS: Well, yes, neither one of us, all three of us didn't have any umbrellas and Berger didn't have any rain gear. We were a little wet, a little cold coming in.

Q. How frustrating was it to bogey the last two holes and perhaps miss the cut?

TIGER WOODS: It was very frustrating. I horseshoed that putt on 7. And then hit a terrible driver on 8. But I hit a wonderful flop shot, hit a bad putt, and then piped it on 9. I only had a wedge in and hit over the green. So it was a little frustrating, yes.

Q. Was your had on backward because of the rain?

TIGER WOODS: I was getting soaked. We were all just soaking wet today.

Q. Even when you have a cold?

TIGER WOODS: Oh, man, it was just brutal.

Q. If you make it through the weekend, what adjustments do you have to make?

TIGER WOODS: Well, hopefully I hit my irons better, because I hit the ball great off the tee today, which I haven't done in a long time. I did some wonderful things, working last night in front of the mirror. I hit the driver great today, unfortunately the strengths of my game are my iron play and my putting and all of a sudden I didn't do that today.

Q. Did you get some offers for a Brelly (small umbrella)?

TIGER WOODS: N, not one of those things. That's not going to keep you dry.
