Final-round Interviews

Interview of Hee-Won Han

THE MODERATOR: Hee-Won, thanks for coming in and joining us. You are playing well. You won last week and runner up this week. We know you have a flight to catch, we'll talk quick. Can you tell us about your day?

HEE-WON HAN: Pretty good. I tried hard, and the putt is not going in, but my shots are pretty good. She playing good.

THE MODERATOR: Was that it. You finished with 11 straight pars, did the putter just cool off?

HEE-WON HAN: I just, um, the 11th hole, I missed the short putt and then the wind is blowing, and it's pretty hard to get a second shot. And then, yeah. I tried hard, but it's not going in.

THE MODERATOR: Okay. We're going to take questions. If you guys have them.

Q What was it like watching her putt out on the 18th, a little nerve racking there? I'm sure. What was that like watching her?

HEE-WON HAN: Yeah. I just wanted to.

Q (Inaudible)?

HEE-WON HAN: Actually that is not that far away. That is her putt. That is why I thought she would make 2-putt.

THE MODERATOR: Were you nervous or did you think she was going to make it?

HEE-WON HAN: I think she is going to make it, not nervous.

Q (Inaudible)?
HEE-WON HAN: Yep.

Q (Inaudible)?
HEE-WON HAN: What is that?

HEE-WON HAN: Yeah. Yeah. I'm pretty good.

Q How was it this week coming off a big win? How does it feel to get back, you played really well (inaudible)?
HEE-WON HAN: It's pretty tired because we played until Monday. And, yeah, and so a little bit tired. But I play pretty good here. It's okay.

Q You played well here in the past, this is your fourth top finish in four years.
HEE-WON HAN: Really.

Q Is there anything particular that you like about this area or do you play good golf here?
HEE-WON HAN: Yeah, actually my second year I missed one shot by Cristie Kerr and second place. I don't know I like here. And last year, and this year it's like the same situation. I just won last weekend and played well, and that is.

Q That is right.

Q You new you birdied at 16, and she was on the 17th?
HEE-WON HAN: I knew her 15th par 5, that is an easy course. I missed that a little on the side. I think she made that birdie, but 16 is pretty tough today. The wind is blowing that way and the pin is little bit on the right side. That is a good birdie there.
HEE-WON HAN: That is why she won.

Q (Inaudible)?
HEE-WON HAN: That was, I think.

Q Can you talk about how you are playing now with the wind last week? We talked about on the way up here last year, you won toward the end of the year, it's always better to finish on a high note.
HEE-WON HAN: It's pretty comfortable. Shot is good and putting is good. Everything is good.

Q Everything is good?
HEE-WON HAN: Yeah.

Q (Inaudible)?
HEE-WON HAN: I hit a good shot, but I missed it.

Q Can you tell us about that shot on 17?
HEE-WON HAN: Um, 17, the pin is just right-hand side, near the water, and I just hit 6-iron, and that was like 10 feet.

Q And then you 2-putted?

HEE-WON HAN: Yes.

Q And then coming up 18?

HEE-WON HAN: I missed a little bit, and made 2 putts. That was a pretty difficult putt.

Q (Inaudible) you ran it past the hole on 18?

HEE-WON HAN: Yes, I just try but.

Q You were trying for the birdie?

HEE-WON HAN: Yes.

THE MODERATOR: Can you take us over the scorecard today.

(SCORECARD)

Q (Inaudible).

HEE-WON HAN: She finished even par today. I think the wind is blowing this afternoon makes it a little difficult. That is it.

Q Jeff, are you all set?

HEE-WON HAN: Thank you.
