AN INTERVIEW WITH MORGAN PRESSEL

Q. The first day you want to post numbers, get it out there, a good first round do you think?

MORGAN PRESSEL: Yes, you know I played decently today. Nothing spectacular. But I didn't play too bad. I did sit around a little bit out there. I chipped in once, that was nice. I made a couple of good putts, but I'm playing pretty well.

Q. Five birdies today, a couple of bogeys, are you pretty happy overall with your performance?

MORGAN PRESSEL: Yes, I mean I played okay. I like to have a few more solid shots going into the weekend. I really screwed a few, played poorly, especially the last few holes. That happens.

Q. It's hard to say (Inaudible). You are in the neighborhood probably, is that something that you just concentrate on for the first round, just being in the hunt?

MORGAN PRESSEL: Closer to scoring. You can't win the tournament on the first day. But you certainly can lose it. So just go out and play well. I bogeyed a hole on the front 9. Just stay patient and birdie the next one. So things like that. It's the first day.

Q. Anything in particular you want to change going into your second round?

MORGAN PRESSEL: I just like to hit a few more solid shots. I just hit a few too many shots that got away from me. Yes, other than that, I putted probably -- my stroke I felt pretty confident with today, more than I probably have in a while.

Q. Is Thursday more about striking distance?

MORGAN PRESSEL: Definitely, I mean I'm not going to win the tournament today. I played okay. I'm right in there.
